The Fanny Mendelssohn Sponsorship is awarded annually. The primary objective of its initiator, Heide Schwarzweller, is to promote musicians with visions they want to implement in absolute freedom. “It is my aim to accompany young and highly talented artists on their career path and to provide them with the artistic freedom they need to thrive.”

The Fanny Mendelssohn Förderpreis (FMFP) pays tribute to an innovative musical concept, a new interpretative approach along with an exceptional repertoire derived from the concept – the works of Fanny Mendelssohn not being a requirement. Artists from the categories voice (age limit: 29), solo instrument and chamber music ensemble (age limit: 25) can apply after being nominated by one of the existing mentors or - after consultation with the Fanny Mendelssohn Förderverein - by an internationally renowned musician, university professor or cultural manager, who will speak for the applicant and accompany him/her during the application process.

The FMFP comes with a prize of € 10,000. The winner will have the opportunity to release his/her debut CD without the pressure of any commercial considerations.
